and referred to Mess^{rs} Stouffer Carry & Small.

The Committee appointed on the Petition of
Isaiah Baldernstone and others reported a bill
entitled an Ordinance appropriating a sum
of money for the building a wharf at the
west end of Pitt Street which was read
a first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The Bill entitled an Ordinance directing returns
to be made by the several Officers therein
mentioned was read a second time and
passed and thereupon transmitted to the
Second Branch and by them returned passed.

The Petition of John Crawford and others was
read and ordered to lie on the table.

The Ordinance for the more effectual inspection
of herrings and other fish was returned to the
Second Branch passed with amendments.
