The communication from the Register of the City respecting the revision of the City Ordinances was read and referred to the consideration of the Second Branch.

The communication of Samuel Green, Surveyor proposing to make a correct map of the City and precincts of the City of Baltimore, was read and ordered to lie on the table.

The memorial of Christopher Hughes respecting the Bason was read and ordered to lie on the table.

The communication of Saul Chase respecting the extension of his wharf into the

Bason was read and ordered to lie on the table.

The following resolution was read and ordered to lie on the table,

Resolved that it shall be the duty of the clerks of the several markets within the City of Baltimore to have the roofs of said Market houses swept at least once every week during the Summer months.

The Petition of James Biays praying permission to extend his wharf near Elizabeth Street on Fell's Point was read and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion therefor next Wednesday was appointed by the Branch, as the day to take up in Committee of the whole ^{the consideration of} the Additional Supplement to "an act to erect Baltimore Town in Baltimore County into a City and to incorporate the inhabitants thereof;

On motion therefor the Branch adjourned until next Monday afternoon at three o'clock.
