The Committee on the petition of James Biays reported a bill entitled an ordinance authorizing James Biays to build a wharf on the South side of Alisanda Street in the eighth ward - which was read a first and by special order a second time and will pass and thereupon was transmitted to the Second Branch.

On motion it was resolved that a Committee be appointed to examine the situation of that part of Alburnale Street which lays between Prince and Wilks Street and that part of Wilks Street which lays between Alburnale and Allen Streets - and to report thereon by bill or otherwise, and Messrs. Inman and Frederick Schaeffer were appointed for that purpose.

The Committee on the petition of Walter brook and others reported a bill entitled a Supplement to an ordinance entitled an ordinance for the inspection of Lumber in the city of Baltimore which was read a first time and ordered to lie on the table.

A message was received from the Second Branch stating their agreement to recommend the report of the Joint Committee of accounts in which they requested the concurrence of the first Branch. In answer to which the Second Branch were informed that the first Branch agreed to the proposed recommendation.

The petition of Harry D. Gough & others was read and referred to Messrs. Kellom and Miller who thereupon reported a resolution appropriating a sum of money to repair Billingsgate Street which was read and ordered to lie on the table.

A resolution was read adopted and sent to the Second Branch for their concurrence - requesting the Mayor to purchase and procure to be conveyed to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore (if the same could be done on reasonable terms) a lot or parcel of grounds to be comprised within the extension of the East line of the Powder house to the river and the other part of said lot: to which resolution the Second Branch assented.

On motion the Branch resolved itself into a Committee of the whole Mr. Lorman in the Chair to take up the order of the day viz the amendments proposed by an Act of the General Assembly to the Charter of Incorporation and having taken the same into consideration ~~and~~ decided thereon section by section rose and presented to the President of the Branch a report stating their unanimous rejection of the said amendments and every part thereof which report was unanimously concurred with.
