

The following message was received from  
the Second Branch,

Gentlemen of the First Branch,

We have concurred  
in the resolution appropriating a sum of money  
in favour of Joshua Reynolds, we likewise concur  
in your resolution making appropriations  
in favour of certain fire companies with  
an amendment to wit to strike out the  
word "three" in the second line and to insert  
the word "two" in which amendment the  
concurrence of your branch is requested.  
Answer to which the Second Branch were  
informed that the first Branch would <sup>not</sup> accede  
to the proposed amendment.

The bill entitled an ordinance  
to improve the health of the City of Baltimore and  
for the due performance of quarantine at  
the port of Baltimore was sent to the  
Second Branch.

The bill entitled an ordinance for the  
inspection of flour was read a first and by special  
order a second time and passed and thereupon  
was transmitted to the Second Branch.

A resolution for appropriating a sum not  
exceeding one hundred and fifty dollars for erecting  
a foot bridge alongside of the Stone bridge at the  
intersection of Harford and Wilkes Street was read  
agreed to and sent to the Second Branch.
