

returned by the Second Branch agreed to with an amendment striking out one hundred dollars and inserting in lieu thereof two hundred dollars which amendment being read was approved to and the Second Branch informed thereof.

A bill for authorizing the drawing of a Lottery in the City or Precincts of Baltimore to raise a sum of money for the improvement of the River Susquehanna which was read a first and by special order a second time and passed and thereupon was returned to the Second Branches.

The following resolution was read.

Resolved that the Register be and he is hereby requested to prepare a correct Index and marginal notes to the ordinances passed and those made permanent at the present session of the City Council, two hundred copies, of which together with the act of assembly incorporating the City and the Supplement thereto, and correct references to all the acts of the State Legislature which relate to the police and regulations of the City before its incorporation with notes to be by him prepared expressive of the contents of the said acts referred to the said copies, shall under the direction of the Register be printed and stitched together. For which services

and for collating and transcribing the above ordinances, the Register shall be allowed five hundred dollars to be included in the appropriation bill for the present year. And it is further resolved that the Mayor be and he is hereby requested to cause to be delivered one copy of the said ordinances to the several Officers of the Corporation, to the Justices of the Peace in the City and Precincts and one copy to each of the Clerks of the Federal Court Baltimore County and Criminal Court: and the residue to remain for the use of the Corporation.

A motion was made and adopted to insert after the words "several officers of the Corporation" in the latter part of the resolution the words "to each of the members of the first and Second Branches of the City Council".
