The Branch met agreeably to adjournment
Present

And all other members except W. Buchanan

The resolution respecting the Registers
Corruption &c. was sent to the Second
Branch and by them returned agreed to with
an amendment, which amendment being
read was disagreed to and the Second Branch
informed thereof who thereupon receded from
the said amendment.

The resolution on the same subject
which was received from the Second Branch
was read disagreed to and returned.

The resolution appropriating one
hundred dollars for John Hargrove for
transcribing the ordinances was read agreed
to sent to the Second Branch and by them
returned agreed to.

The bill repealing the ordinance
authorizing James Biays to wharf in and
extend his property on Fell's Point into the
Harbour was returned by the Second Branch
negatived.

The resolution approving of the Bond executed
by William Hayler & others was read and dispen-
sation from.

A Supplement to the butter & hogstead
bill was read a second time passed and sent
to the Second Branch and by them returned
passed.

The Committee on the petition of Ni-
cholas Stansbury reported a bill entitled an
Ordinance authorizing Nicholas Stansbury
to extend therein mentioned, which bill was
read a first and by special order a second
time and passed and thereupon was transmitted
to the Second Branch and by them returned
agreed to, with an amendment, which
amendment being read was agreed to and
the Second Branch informed thereof.

A resolution for the payment of the
Journal of Accounts passed both Branches.

A resolution authorizing the Mayor in
case of necessity to borrow ten thousand dollars
from any of the Banks for the use of the City.

The resolution authorizing fixing & the
penalty of the bond to be given by the com-
missioners appointed by Act of Assembly to
draw a Lottery to finish Trinity Church
was read agreed to and sent to the Second
Branch and by them returned agreed to.
