The order of the day being called for on the Bill entitled "a Supplement to the Ordinance entitled "an Ordinance for the inspection of flows". It was read the first, & by special order the second time, passed, & transmitted to the Second Branch, who returned the same "passed".

The resolution for the erection of a watch house was returned by the Second Branch agreed to

A petition from William Slater & others was read & referred to Mr Ennis & Mr Decker

On Motion leave was given to withdraw the Bill entitled "an Ordinance for the erecting a Hydrant &c" and a bill on the same subject entitled "a Supplement to the Ordinance to encourage the introduction of water into the City of Baltimore" was submitted, read the first & by special order the second time, passed & sent to the Second Branch

A Bill entitled "an Ordinance to repeal so much of the Ordinance regulating the sale of Bread which requires the stamping thereof &c" was received from the Second Branch, read & ordered to lie on the Table

The Bill repealing so much of the Ordinance regulating the Sale of Bread, as requires the marking or stamping thereof was read the first & by special order the second time, passed & returned to the Second Branch

The resolution directing the City Commissioners to cause a correct Survey of the extreme limit of the City to be made, & authorizing them to draw upon the Register for Two hundred & fifty Dollars to complete the same was read concurred in & sent to the Second Branch
