A Bill entitled "an Ordinance to impose a tax on the real and personal property within the City of Baltimore, and to provide for the Collection of the same for the year 1808." was Submitted and read the first time

A Message was received from the Second branch¹⁷⁰ stating that they had concurred in the resolution directing the registers to furnish the City Council with an Annual Account of inspections &c. also with the resolution Appropriating an additional sum to the Clerks of the different Markets -

The Bill entitled "a Supplement to an Ordinance for the regulation of the Markets" was received from the Second branch passed -

a resolution was received from the Second branch for appropriating 50 Dollars for levelling & filling up Great York Street which was read the first & by special order the Second time, concurred in & returned to the Second branch

On Motion Mr Lee was added to the Committee appointed on the petition of William Plata & others

The bill for the introduction of water into the Eastern part of the City of Baltimore was received from the Second branch passed

a Resolution was presented and read appropriating - dollars, to be paid to the Harbour Master as a Compensation for his services for the present year

A resolution appropriating fifteen hundred dollars to be paid out of the City Treasury into the hands of James Biays, Timothy Gardner, Richard Stearns, Archibald Kerr, Baptiste Mezick, Thomas Tenants, George Decker, Jacob Small, & Daniel Howland for the relief of the distressed poor, was read the first & by special order a second time, concurred in & sent to the Second branch & by their return agreed to
