

The Committee appointed on the petition of William Slater to other report a resolution for filling up Polly Street near Trinity Church which was read

The Committee appointed to enquire into the progress of the Mud Machine - report a resolution for appropriating a sum not exceeding 4000 dollars, for building a new Mud Machine, Lecons &c which was read the first & by special order a second time, Concurred in & sent to the second branch and by them returned agreed to

The Bill authorizing the drawing of a lottery for the erection of a Masonic Hall was received from the second branch passed

a resolution was received from the second branch for the appointment of a Joint Committee to draught a scheme of a lottery to raise a sum of money in aid of the City funds - which was read, Concurred in, & W. Buchanan, Mr Tenant & Mr Lorman appointed a committee & the second branch informed thereof

A Bill entitled "a Supplement to the Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to preserve the Navigation of the Harbor of Baltimore & to provide for the exercise of the power vested in the Port Wardens by act of Assembly - was submitted and read the first time

a resolution for appropriating a sum of money to be paid to the Superintendants of Streets, in addition to their Salaries was read the first by special order the second time, Concurred in & sent to the second branch

a message was received from the second branch proposing that when the Branch adjourns they adjourn till Tuesday next - to which the branch assented & informed the second thereof

On motion therefor leave was given to bring in a bill entitled "A Supplement to the Ordinance to Appoint City Commissioners, & prescribing their duties"

A Resolution appropriating 200 dollars, for paving the public wharf at the south end of Market Street in the eighth Ward was read, Concurred in & sent to the second branch

A Resolution for the Appropriation of a sum not exceeding 1200 dollars, for repairing of pumps - was submitted and read

On Motion the branch adjourned until Tuesday next 3 o'clock P.M.
