A Bill entitled "an Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to appoint two Justices of the Peace to receive the report of the Night watch" was read the first & by Special Order a second time, passed & sent to the second branch who returned the same passed -

A Resolution appropriating Two hundred Dollars, to be equally divided between the two Justices appointed by the Mayor to receive the report of the Night watch was read, Concurred in & sent to the 2<sup>d</sup> Branch and by them returned agreed to with an Amendment which Amendment was read, Concurred in, & second branch informed thereof

The Committee to whom were referred the account of expenses of the Judges of Election, to report a resolution for defraying the same, which was read the first & by Special Order a second time, Concurred in & sent to the 2<sup>d</sup> Branch by them returned agreed to -

On motion therefore leave was given to withdraw the Resolution appropriating - Dollars, as a Compensation to the Harbour Master - and a Resolution was submitted in lieu thereof authorizing the Harbour Master to receive for his Compensation the current year, a Commission of 25 per Centum upon the Amount collected by him for wharfage - which Resolution was read the first & by Special Order a second time Concurred in & sent to the 2<sup>d</sup> Branch by them returned agreed to -

The Bill entitled "a Supplement to the Ordinance entitled an Ordinance for the inspection of dumb-bells" was received from the 2<sup>d</sup> Branch, read the first & by Special Order a second time & negated, & second branch informed thereof -

The Resolution appropriating \$ Dollar, & 46 Cents, to pay John Marsh for paving Dutch Alley, was read a second time & disagreed to

A Communication was received from Second Branch proposing that when the branch shall adjourn they adjourn until Thursday next, in order to give the Mayor an opportunity of examining the bills which have passed &c to which proposition this branch assented & informed the other branch thereof
