In pursuance of a resolution passed for that purpose - the Council assembled in the Chamber of the first branch and having appointed Messrs Tenant and Pringle as Tellers, proceeded to the appointment by ballot of the following officers To the office of Collector John Hopkins, Sumner & John Hunter To the office of assessor for the first District George Secker and John Brewitt second District Samuel Vincent and Adam Honeman, and William Mondel and John Bayron for the third District To the office of Commissioners of Health, Adam Tonissen & John Crawford for the Western District, Samuel H Gatchell & John Bayron for the Eastern District To the office of Harbor Master Joseph Smith & John Snyder, to the office of Gauge Philip E Eckel and Jarrett Burt, To the office

of Inspector of fish Maybury Parks and David P. To the office of Keeper of the Standard of weight and measure, William H Wood and Christopher Raborg, To the office of Superintendants of streets, Frederick Lumwalt & William Savory for the western district, and John Hawking and George Baudece for the Eastern District - which persons, having the highest number of votes, were duly returned as such to the Mayor

The Branch having finished all business laid before them on motion adjourned sine die
