The Resolution appropriating One hundred and fifty dollars, to fill up a pond in Queen Street was returned by the Second branch who concurred therein.

The Resolution appropriating a sum of money for erecting and lighting an additional number of lamps was returned by the 2^d Branch Concurred in with proposed amendments which were read Concurred in & 2^d Branch informed thereof.

A Resolution appropriating a sum not exceeding Two hundred dollars, for filling up Washington Street between Fleck & the South side of Alisanne Street was read from the 2^d Branch, was Concurred in, & returned.

A Message was received from the Second branch proposing to proceed to Morrow afternoon to the nomination of Officers, acting under the Ordinance of the Corporation, in which proposition the branch Concurred with a proposed amendment adding thereto that "no member of either branch of the City Council shall be nominated to either of the Offices under this Corporation." the Second branch being informed thereof disagreed to the proposed amendment, a message was thereupon sent to the 2^d Branch insisting upon the proposed amendment, and proposing the appointment of a Joint Committee to confer thereon, & stating the appointment of Messrs. Buchanan, Small & Luyden for that purpose - in which proposition the Second branch Concurred & appointed Messrs. Stouffer and Brays as such Committee on their part - The Committee of Conference having reported that they had agreed to recommend to the Second branch an acquiescence in the said amendment, the report was Concurred in & a message received from the other branch stating that they receded from their disagreement to the proposed amendment.

A message was received from the 2^d Branch proposing to authorize the Mayor to request the attendance of John Templeman of Leeds Town to confer on the propriety of building a chain Bridge over Jones' Falls &c. & to defray the expense of such journey - which was read, nonconcurrent in & 2^d Branch informed thereof.
