

775 The Bill entitled "A Supplement to the ordinance to prevent Nuisance and to enforce useful regulations within the City of Baltimore" was returned by the 2^d branch passed

A petition from David Shields & others on behalf of the Mechanical fire Company praying for an appropriation to purchase a lot of ground for the purpose of building a suitable engine house thereon, was presented, read & referred to Messrs Buchanan, Hewitt & Mummy

A Report of a Committee in the second branch to whom was referred a Memorial from William C. Gouldsmith & George Reinecke was received from the second branch, read, now concurred in & returned

A Bill entitled "An Ordinance imposing a tax on the real & personal property within the City of Baltimore & to provide for the collection of the same for the year Eighteen hundred & ten" was submitted, read & by special order read a second time, passed & sent to the second branch

A Resolution appropriating four hundred dollars for the purpose of changing the course of the stream of water now passing across Market & Bond Streets, so as to run down German Street, including two hundred dollars appropriated on the 21st instant for building a bridge over a gully in the 7th ward, was received from the 2^d Branch read & referred to Messrs Emmis, Sheppard & Siffenduff

276 The Resolution appropriating One hundred dollars for raising and repaving the lower end of Fleet Street adjoining Washington Street, was returned by the second branch concurred in

A Resolution appropriating a sum of money not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars for paving the west side of Bowley Wharf was received from the second branch, read, concurred in & returned

A Resolution appropriating the sum of three hundred and fifty one dollar & thirty three cents, to pay Elisha & George Bayley for paving done in Howard Street between Camden and Conway Streets, in Front Street, between Low & Wapping Streets, in Tumblestone Alley, was received from the 2^d Branch, read & referred to Messrs Emmis, Stewart & Hewitt

A Report and resolution from a Committee in the second branch to whom was referred that part of the Mayor's communication recommending provision to be made for the poor, was received from the second branch read, concurred in & returned with a proposal to have the same published in which the 2^d branch concurred

The Bill supplementary to the Ordinance appointing City Commissioners & prescribing their duties was returned by the second branch negatived

The petition of Lehu Boildin praying for a remuneration of losses sustained by him in a contract made with the City Commissioners for supplying out the Coffa dan in Long Folly &c was read a second time, for motion resolved that the petitioners have leave to withdraw his petition
