* A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to pay
out of any unappropriated money in the
City Treasury to Elisha & George Bayley, John
Marsh & William B Lupton such sum or sums
of money as may become due to them for
paving heretofore done, prior to the next
annual meeting of the City Council, was
submitted, read, concurred in & sent to the
second branch & by them concurred in &
returned

The resolution for the appointment of a
Joint Committee of both branches for the
purpose of drafting & presenting to the next
General Assembly of Maryland a memorial
praying for an increase of powers to the
Corporation of the City of Baltimore was
returned by the 2^d Branch Non Concurred in

A Message was sent to the 2^d Branch
stating that the first branch having closed
the business of the session proposed to
adjourn sine die to which proposal
the 2^d Branch acceded.

Thereupon on motion therefor the branch
adjourned sine die
