The City Council having assembled in the Chamber of the first branch proceeded to the nomination of proper persons to fill the office of Superintendants of Streets and Pumps. — when the following persons having the greatest number of votes agreeably to the order in which they are respectively named, were accordingly returned to the Mayor. —
