A petition from John Gryock & others residents
of Pitt Street from Green to Harford Street
inclusion, praying that the City Council would
direct a location or survey thereof to be made
was presented, read and ordered to lie on
the Table.

The Resolution authorizing the Mayor to
purchase for the use of the City such part
of the lot adjoining the North side of the
Eastern abutment of the New Stone Bridge
as he should think necessary, to afford a
free passage of the water through the Arch
thereof was read a second time, concurred
in & sent to the 2^d Branch & by them
concurred in & returned.

A message was received from the Second branch
stating that they had access to the papers
for proceeding on Wednesday next to the
nomination of all City Officers.

The Committee appointed for that purpose report
a Bill entitled "An Ordinance appropriating
a sum of money for erecting a Stone Bridge
over Jones' Falls" which was read the first time.

The Bill received from the Second branch entitled
"An Ordinance authorizing the building of Bridges
over Jones' Falls" was read a second and third
time, negatived and returned.

A Bill entitled "An Ordinance to provide for
the erecting a Stone Bridge over Jones' Falls
at the crossing of Gay Street" was submitted
and read the first time.

On Motion Messrs. Kell, Jamieson & Wilson
were appointed a Committee to view the Site
of the Bridge on Gay Street and report
the most suitable plan for erecting a
Stone Bridge thereon.

On Motion therefore the Branch adjourned
until Monday afternoon next 3 o'clock.
