

The Committee appointed for that purpose made the following report which was read

The Committee who were instructed to view the Site of Griffiths bridge over Jones Falls, and to report the most proper mode of erecting a stone bridge at that place, beg leave to report. That they have attended to the duty assigned to them, and find the Street on each side of said Bridge to be forty six feet wide. That the width ascertained by the board of Park warding for the limits of the Falls, is on the South side of said bridge sixty feet, and that the width of the falls (if established) is on the North side of said bridge sixty six feet, six inches. That the whole weight and pressure of water is against the west abutment of the bridge.

That your Committee are of opinion that a Bridge of one arch, may be conveniently erected, and is the preferable mode of building the same. They are also of opinion that the Bridge ought to be of the full width of the Street - all which is submitted
