report recommending that said petition lie on
the Table, which report was Concurred in

The Bill entitled "An Ordinance respecting the
Mud Machine & for other purposes" was
returned by the Second Branch passed with
proposed amendments, which were read
& agreed to & the Second Branch informed
thereof

The Resolution Appropriating Eighty Dollars for
altering or repairing the roof of the watch
house in the 7th ward was returned by the
Second Branch Concurred in

The Committee to whom was referred the resolution
from the Second Branch appropriating a sum
of money to fill up Castle Alley one hundred
feet above Fleet Street, to the grade &c made
a report recommending the adoption of said
resolution, which report was agreed to and
the resolution being again read was Concurred
in and returned to the Second Branch

The Bill entitled "An Ordinance to impose
a tax on all the real and personal
property within the city of Baltimore" was
returned by the Second Branch passed
with proposed amendments, which were
read & Concurred in & the Second Branch
informed thereof

A Message was received from the Second
Branch proposing that when the City
Council adjourned it would adjourn
until Monday next the 2nd March, to
which the Branch disagreed, & a Message was
sent to the Second Branch proposing in
lieu of Monday to adjourn until Tues-
-day next the 4th of March, to which the
Second Branch assented.

Thereupon on motion therefor the Branch
adjourned until Wednesday the 4th
day of March next.
