The Committee to whom was referred the¹⁴¹ petition of Lewis Hart reported the following resolution which was read agreed to, and sent to the Second Branch

Resolved that the petition of Lewis Hart praying for a compensation for rebuilding the foot bridge over the Falls at or near Pratt Street, be and the same is hereby referred to the City Commissioners, who are authorized to make him such compensation with the approbation of the Mayor as they may think him entitled to, to be drawn for, out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury

A Petition from Sylvester Brady & David Micker praying for an appropriation to pay them Thirty Six dollars & Eighteen Cents due for paving a lot on Argyle Alley, was presented read & referred to Messrs Sheppard, Lynde & Synson
