The Committee to whom was referred the Consideration of examining and estimating the Expenses necessary to raise and Repave the space between the Upper and Lower Centre Market Houses & Spouting the East side of the same have performed that duty, and submit the following Resolution.

Resolved that a sum not exceeding four hundred dollars be included in the Appropriation Bill of the present session, for the purpose of raising and Repaving the space between the Upper and Lower Centre Market Houses, and for Spouting the East side of the same; to be expended under the direction of the City Commissioners, with the approbation of the Mayor. Which being read a first & by special order a second time was concurred in.

The Committee to whom was referred the petition of Sunday inhabitants of the Seventh Ward, relative to Petticoat Alley made their report as follows.

The Committee to whom was referred the petition of Sunday inhabitants on Petticoat Alley, by leave to report by Resolution. Viz.

Resolved by both Branches of the City Council that there be added to the Appropriation Bill for the present year the sum of Two Hundred dollars for

the purpose of filling up to paving height that part of Petticoat Alley between Gough and German Streets at present not paved; to be expended under the the direction of the City Commissioners with the approbation of the Mayor: And that the said Commissioners forthwith complete the same agreeably to the prayer of the owners of property on said Alley, now before them. Which being read a first and by special order a second time & concurred in - And sent to the Second Branch, who returned the same endorsed "Concurred in".

The following Resolution was on motion submitted.

Resolved that the City Commissioners, if called upon to grade Hayford Street, shall fix and determine the grade thereof, to be of such altitude as may suit the conveying of the water down said Street by a Tunnel or open Canal, which ever may be hereafter adopted - And as may afford the most effectual discharge practicable for the said water from Wilks Street into the Basin, or its junction with Jones's Falls.

And the said Commissioners are hereby directed to enquire into and obtain as just estimate as can be had of the whole expense of improving Hayford Street in either of the above modes, including the expense of filling and paving the same, and whether piling therein will be necessary. And
