Resolved, That the City Commissioners, with the approbation of the Mayor be & they are hereby authorized to contract with John Gross for the straightening of the East line of Jones Falls in front of his Lot bounding thereon, so as to permit the walling thereof to be flush with the abutment of the Bridge lately erected over said Falls. And also with Jacob Miller for the extension of the same line through the point or corner of his Lot, provided the same will in their opinion judgment promote the public convenience. Which being read a first & by Special Order a second time was concurred in & sent to the second Branch.

The Committee to whom was referred the Petition of John Holbo and others respecting the sewer which runs through W. Powers' Lot made their Report as follows: "That in the opinion

of the Committee a small appropriation would be advisable, to repair the sewer running through W. Powers' Lot, to be expended under the direction of the City Commissioners, and would therefore recommend the introduction of the same into the appropriation Bill the present year." Which was read a first

and by Special Order a second time and ordered to lie on the table to be provided for in the General Appropriation Bill.

The Resolution appointing one Commissioner to each Ward, was on motion ordered to a second Reading, and after debate thereupon was read a third time and non-concurred in. The yeas and nays being requested appeared as follows:
