The Bill entitled "An Ordinance regulating the inspection of Lime in the City & Precincts of Baltimore" was received back from the 2^d Branch endorsed "In 2^d Branch March 1st 1814 Read the first time & ordered to lie on the table." - March 3rd Read the 2^d time & will not pass.

The Bill entitled "A Supplement to an Ordinance to unite the powers and duties of the City Commissioners & Commissioners of Health" was returned from the second Branch, endorsed "In 2^d Branch March 1st 1814, Read the first time & ordered to lie on the table"; March 3rd 1814 Read the 2^d time and will pass with the proposed amendments. By Order *Mr. Rogers*

Amendments proposed, 1st Strike out the second section and insert "And be it enacted and ordained that whenever the said Commissioners disagree in opinion on any subject within their jurisdiction, they shall apply to the Mayor to appoint a third person to act as umpire between them, the Mayor or any two of whom to be decisive, subject nevertheless to like appeal as is provided for in the sixth section of the

to appoint City Commissioners and prescribe their duties in all cases mentioned in said section."

Strike out the words "are" in the third line of the third section and insert "Or any other ordinance of the Corporation". Which amendments were concurred in and the second Branch informed thereof by message.

A Resolution appropriating the sum of three hundred Dollars for the use of the Fire Company called "Robert's Guards" was received from the second Branch, read a first & by special order the second time, concurred in and returned.

The report of the Committee on the petition of the "Union Fire Company" together with the Resolution appropriating the sum of \$1654.00 for the purposes therein mentioned, was received back from the second Branch endorsed "In 2^d Branch March 1st 1814 Read the first time & ordered to lie on the table." - March 3rd 1814 Read the second time and assented to.

A Resolution directing the Mayor to take immediate measures for the recovery of all debts due this Corporation, was on motion submitted and read a first, and by special order the second time, concurred in and sent to the second Branch for their concurrence, who returned the same endorsed "Concurred in".
