referred the Communications of the City Commissioners
relative to the damages sustained by the late heavy
rains, beg leave to state, that they have considered the
matter of said communications and recommend the pass-
ing of the two Resolutions herewith submitted

Resolved by both branches of the City Council, that
the City Commissioners are hereby authorized when they repair
the Bridge on Queen & Harford Streets, to build the wall
at the abutments of said Bridge, twenty feet apart instead
of fifteen, as directed by an Ordinance passed the
Twenty first March Eighteen hundred and
fourteen."

"Resolved by both Branches of the City Council that the
City Commissioners be and are hereby authorized to build
a Stone wall from the abutment of Queen and Harford Street
Bridge, on each side of Harford Street run in a straight line
to King George Street Bridge, bringing said wall fifteen feet
apart at King George Street. Said wall to be built suffi-
ciently strong and high, so as to contain the water in times
of heavy rains, and fill up on the outside thereof so as
to prevent said wall from being propped out. Also to have
the bottom of said Canal paved with good and sufficient
stone, at a grade of about one inch fall in ten feet.
And further that they are hereby authorized to repair
the injury done by the late rains on Wilks Street East of
Washington Street, and cut down and fill up Ann Street
south of Dulany Street. And to accomplish the above
objects that the sum of three thousand five hundred
dollars be and is hereby appropriated, to be expended
under the direction of the City Commissioners in
conjunction with the Mayor."

Which Report and Resolutions were severally read
the first and by special order a second time con-
current in and sent to the second Branch for their
concurrence. Who returned the same endorsed
