

51 Pannells petition made their report by submitting the following Resolution, to wit: "Resolved that the Mayor of the City of Baltimore be and he is hereby directed to pay out of any money in the Treasury to Edward Pannell, the sum of Five hundred and twenty nine dollars and ninety two cents, on condition that the said Pannell deliver to the Mayor an acceptance of the Corporation held by the said Pannell bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> June 1819, drawn by the City Commissioners in favour of Brady & Nichol, and on the further condition that the said Pannell transfer to the use of the City, in such manner as may be approved of by the Mayor, any suit or suits which may have been instituted by the said Pannell against James Johns or Benjamin Fowler".

Which having been read was ordered to lie on the table.

The Committee to whom was referred the application of Doctor William Steward for augmentation of Salary made Report and submitted the following Resolution, to wit:

"Resolved by both Branches of the City Council that the sum of One hundred dollars be included in the appropriation Bill to be added to the present salary of the health officer".

Which having been read was ordered to lie on the table.

A Communication from John Hargrove Esquire, City Register praying augmentation of Salary, was presented read and ordered to lie on the table.

The Resolution authorizing the City Commissioners with the approbation of the Mayor to purchase a piece of ground for a second Eastern Pottery field" was sent to the second Branch for their concurrence, - who returned the same endorsed "Assented to".

53 The Resolution making provision for those Citizens who were wounded, and the families of such as were killed at the battles of Bladensburg, Fort M<sup>c</sup>Henry & North Point, was on motion read a second time, unanimously concurred in and the concurrence of the second Branch requested.

The Report of the Committee on the subject of a "City Hall" was on motion read a second time & ordered to lie on the table, that is to say, made the order of the day for Thursday next.

The Committee to whom that part of the Mayors message respecting the New Edition of the City Ordinances was referred, submitted the following Report.

"That having taken the subject into full consideration, they are of opinion that the editorial part of the work, has been conducted with ability, judgment and fidelity - and the typographical with accuracy and neatness. They therefore submit the following Resolution.

"Resolved by both Branches of the City Council, that there be paid to Samuel Young, as a full compensation for his trouble in preparing a new Edition of the City Ordinances & the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars, out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury - And that the Mayor be authorized to allow & pay to Thomas Rogers and John Hargrove, such sums respectively as he may deem them entitled to for the services rendered by them, with respect to the aforesaid work".

Which Report & Resolution having been read was ordered to lie on the table.

The following Resolution was submitted, read & ordered to lie on the table viz:

"Resolved that a Committee be appointed to report
