

Monday March 25<sup>th</sup> 1816.

The Branch met agreeably to adjournment, present William Patterson Esq: president & all the other Members except Mr Brevitt.

The Resolution directing the erection of Lamps in the different wards therein specified - and the Resolution making a further appropriation for erecting Lamps in the seventh Ward, were sent to the second Branch for their concurrence - and were returned, severally endorsed "Assented to".

A Message was received from the Mayor informing the First Branch of the City Council that he had approved and signed an Ordinance entitled "A further supplement to the Ordinance for Regulating and inspecting Weights and measures used within the City and Precincts of Baltimore"; and also an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance more effectually to prevent the spreading of Fires in the City of Baltimore" - and likewise an Ordinance entitled "A further additional Supplement to the Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance for the inspection of Fish in the City of Baltimore" - All of which Originated in your Branch". signed, "Edw. Johnson".

Which having been read was ordered to lie on the table.

A Message was sent to the second branch, "proposing with their concurrence to resume the nomination of City Officers to the Mayor" - which being agreed to the second Branch immediately attended, and the City Council proceeded to make the following Nominations to office - Viz:
