

202 Continuation of the second branch

We concur in your proposal that the joint Committee on the subject of Washington Street be so enlarged as to include the whole of both branches and visit the ground on Saturday next at ten o'clock in the forenoon and we further propose that the said Committee meet at the intersection of Market and Delany Streets and that the City Commissioners and Port Wardens be directed to attend at the said time and place to give the said Committee any information in their power.

Which proposal was agreed to by message from the second Branch.

The following Resolution was on motion submitted. *Viz*

2^d "Resolved that the sum of hundred dollars be added to the appropriation to the Vigilant Fire Company to aid them in liquidating certain claims against them for apparatus & a section engine, as well as to enable them to procure an additional quantity of hose: provided that the Company produce to the Register vouchers for the actual expenditure thereof."

Which being read it was moved that the blank be filled with the sum of Five, which having been done, the Resolution was read a second time, and on the question being put "shall this Resolution pass as filled" it was determined in the Negative.

3^d It was then moved that the following Resolution be acted on *Viz* "Resolved that the sum of dollars be appropriated to the New Market Fire Company to aid them in paying for a House lately erected for the safe keeping of their apparatus" which Resolution having been read, it was moved to fill the blank with the sum of "Five hundred dollars" & rejected. "Four hundred dollars" was proposed and carried. - The blank was then filled with the sum of "Four hundred dollars" the Resolution read a second time and concurred in.

The following Resolution No. 4. was then submitted and read the first time. When after several unsuccessful motions to insert larger sums, the blank was filled with the sum of one hundred dollars. *Viz*:

"Resolved that the sum of One hundred dollars be added to the appropriation to the "First Alarm" Fire Company to aid them in paying for a House lately erected for the safe keeping of their apparatus" Which Resolution as it now stands having been read a second time was concurred in.

The Resolution No. 5. was submitted *Viz*:

Resolved that the sum of dollars be added to the appropriation to the Independent Fire Company to aid them in building an engine house for the purpose of securing their apparatus"

Which having been read the first time, it was moved that the blank be filled with the sum of "Five hundred dollars" On the question being put from the chair it was determined in the Negative - The Yeas & Nays being required appeared as follows,
