

Thursday March 27th 1817.

The Branch met agreeably to adjournment present William Peterson Esquire President and all the other members except M. McCulloch.

The Resolution making appropriation for cutting down Montgomery Street, was returned from the second Branch indorsed "Assented to".

A Petition from Thomas Coats & others, complaining of the decayed & broken state of the pavements in Bank Street and Public Alley and praying that the same may be repaired &c. Was submitted, Read and referred to Messrs. Berry, Mofick & Jamison to consider & Report thereon.

On motion therefor a message was sent to the second Branch, "proposing with their concurrence and agreeably to the Order of the day, to go into the nominations of City officers to the Mayor, and inviting their attendance in the Chamber of the First Branch for that purpose". Whereupon the second Branch immediately attended and the City Council proceeded to make the following nominations of City Officers, to the Mayor.
