

254 The following Resolution was read from the second Branch to wit, Resolved by both Branches of the City Council that the sum of One Thousand dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of purchasing a suitable lot of ground for the erection of a *Protestant House* thereon."

(Which having been read the first and by special order a second time, was concurred in ^{with} the proposed amendment viz "And that the aforesaid lot shall be selected and purchased by the Mayor and Port Wardens of the City, and that it shall not be more than one half a mile distance from the navigable water of the Harbour ———"

The following Resolution together with a note of explanation from George Hill was received from the second Branch "Resolved by both branches of the City Council that the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized to extend the time of payment of George Hill's Note to the Corporation of Baltimore, given in payment for property purchased of said Corporation during the preceding year, for two Thousand Dollars to 30 or 40 days at his option, the said George Hill giving to the Mayor satisfactory security for the payment thereof" Which being read the first and by special order a second time, assented to and returned ———

A Bill entitled, "A Supplement to the Ordinance, entitled An Ordinance to provide for laying out Election districts in the City of Baltimore", was received from the second Branch, read the first and by special order a second time, passed and returned ———
