The Bill entitled "An Ordinance providing for the erection of a market house in addition to the Lexington market house" was read a second time, on motion by Mr Pease it was referred to Messrs Pease, Rose, Moore

The Resolution making an appropriation for Doctor Monckton was read a second time and concurred in.

The Bill entitled "A supplement to the Ordinance entitled the Ordinance for completing the Baltimore Monument" was read a second time & Mr. Pease

The Mayor submitted thro the Register sundry letters from John Scott, Mr Howard and John P. Lyon Esqs, delegates to the General Assembly, which were read, and on motion by Mr Sheth were referred to the Second Branch.

A Bill entitled "An Ordinance to fix the salary of the City Counselor" was received from the Second Branch, read a first time & ordered to lie on the table.

A Bill entitled "An Ordinance to fix the salaries of certain officers therein mentioned" was received from the Second Branch, read a first time & on motion by Mr Hubbard the above stated two Bills were referred to Messrs Hubbard, Heath & Sheth.

The Report of the Committee appointed to prepare rules for conducting business between the two Branches was read a second time and concurred in. done

Mr Ridgely presented a petition from Frederick Stakins and others relative to mud carts in Pratt street, which was read and referred to Messrs Ridgely, Lynch and Moore. done

Mr Heath from the Committee delivered a Report and the following Resolution which was read a first and by special order the second time and concurred in.

Resolved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore that the Register be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to William Goyne seventy five dollars in full of his charge against the City of Baltimore for printing done for said City during the year 1825. done

Mr Finley from the Committee delivered the following Report which was read a first and by special order the second time and concurred in.

Resolved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore that the Register be and he is hereby directed to pay to Francis J. Dalland or his order out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury the sum of thirty seven dollars expended by him in the erection of a store in the office of the City Collector.

Mr Russell from the Committee delivered a Report also a Bill entitled "An Ordinance for the relief of George Sumner" which was read a first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr Wright presented a petition from C. Capito and others for a lamp which was read and referred to the Committee on lamps. done

The Amendments from the Second Branch, to the Bill, entitled "A further supplement to the Ordinance entitled the Ordinance to regulate the riding and driving of Horses and carriages &c" was read a second time, the 1st & 2^d amendments were concurred in and the 3^d departed from and on motion by Mr Finley a message was sent to the Second Branch requesting them to reconsider and recede from the same.

Mr Hubbard from the Committee, to whom were referred the two Bills relative to the reduction of the salaries of the several Officers therein mentioned, delivered a Report which was read a first time and ordered to lie on the table.
