

The Resolution making an Appropriation for printing done by William Heyman was returned from the second Branch endorsed concurred in.

The Bill entitled A Supplement to An Ordinance entitled An Ordinance for completing the Baltimore Monument was returned from the second Branch endorsed, reconsidered and Will not pass. On motion by Mr. Finley a message was sent to the second Branch proposing with their concurrence the appointment of a Committee of conference on the same, and naming on the part of the Branch Messrs. Heatto, Finley and Stebb. The second Branch assented to the proposal appointed on their part Messrs. Shaffer and Parke and informed this Branch thereof by message.

The Bill entitled An Ordinance permitting James Ramsay to extend his horse rope walk to his line on Smith's Street, was returned from the second Branch endorsed Will pass.

The amendments from the second Branch to the Bill entitled An Ordinance to provide for the payment of sundry expenses of the City Court of Baltimore and of the City Poor at the Poor House were read a second time and concurred in, and the Bill will pass as amended.

The Resolution making an Appropriation for a stove in the Collector's office was returned from the second Branch endorsed concurred in.

Mr. Finley from the Committee returned the Bill entitled An Ordinance fixing the limits of the markets therein mentioned, which was read and Will pass with the following amendments.

- 1st After the word space in the 7th line of the 1st section, insert the words "from house to house".
- 2nd Before the word Enter in the second line of the third section insert "Exit".
- 3rd Strike out the words "of that part" in the interlineation in the first line of the 3rd section.
- 4th In the 7th line of the same section strike out the word "And" and insert "And be it Enacted and Ordained that" making it the commencement of a 4th section.
- 5th After the word street in the 14th line from the bottom of the second page insert "from house to house".
- 6th Make the 4th section the 3rd.
- 7th Make the 3rd section the 6th.
- 8th In the 6th line of the last mentioned section strike out "Renew" and insert "take out".

9th After the word granted in the 10th line of the same section, insert the words "And any person or persons who shall occupy any stand stall or bench without a license for the same each and every."

10th After the words case may be in the next line insert "for each and every such offence".

11th In the next line strike out 5 and insert 2.

12th Make the 6th section the 7th.

13th In the 7th and 8th lines of the last mentioned section strike out the words "in the opinion of the Clerk or Clerks of the several Markets" and strike out in the two next lines the words "whom they or either of them shall have good cause to believe and insert "Who".

14th In the 8th and 9th lines from the bottom of the 1st page being slice in the same section strike out the words "in the opinion or belief of the Clerk of the markets".

15th In the next line above strike out 5 and insert 2. or

16th In the interlineation two lines below strike out 5 and insert 2. or

17th After the word described in the 9th line from the bottom insert "And".

18th In the last line but one of the same page strike out 5 and insert 2.

19th After the word Ordinance at the end of the page insert "Provided that any person or persons buying vegetables or domestic fruit, except oranges, limes and lemons, only with intention to sell again shall pay for such license one dollar and no more."

20th Strike out the last line but one of the same section and insert "in the City of Baltimore or within five or ten miles thereof."

21st Make the 7th section the 8th.

22nd In the 17th line of the last mentioned section strike out 5 and insert 2.

23rd Make the 8th section the 9th.

24th Make the 9th section the 10th.

On motion the Branch adjourned until 3 o'clock tomorrow evening
