## No. 1.

An Ordinance for closing up part of the old Joppa Road.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and Old Joppa City Council of Baltimore, That the commissioners for open-road to be ing streets be and they are hereby authorised and required to close and shut up all that part of the old Joppa road which lies between the west side of Broadway and the east side of Bond street; provided that the several parties owning the ad-Proviso. joining grounds, pay to the city Register the value of the said street so to be closed, in just and equal proportions according to their several interests therein; said value to be ascertained and determined by the said commissioners for opening of streets.
