An Ordinance to open Orchard street from Tessier street to Pennsylvania avenue.

Preamble.

Whereas, Richard Dorsey has made application to the City Council for the opening of Orchard street, from its present termination at Tessier street to Pennsylvania avenue, and the legal notice of sixty days having been published in two of the daily papers of the city of Baltimore, in conformity with the provisions of the act of Assembly of 1839, chap. 226, &c., and such application appearing just and reasonable; there-

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and to be opened. City Council of Baltimore, That the commissioners for opening streets, be and they are hereby authorized to open Orchard street between Tessier street and Pennsylvania avenue, as follows: Beginning for the northermost side of Orchard street as contemplated to be opened, at the south corner of Mrs. McAllister's three story brick ware-house on Pennsylvania avenue, and running thence north-easterly, parallel with Biddle street, about (200 feet) two hundred feet to Tessier street, thence south-easterly bounding on said Tessier street, fifty-four feet and nine inches to the southeastermost side of Richard Dorsey's lot, thence southwestwardly to Pennsylvania avenue, at a point fifty-four feet and nine inches, southeasterly from the south corner of Mrs. McAllister's three story brick ware-

SEC. 2. Be it enacted and ordained, That the said board of commissioners for opening streets shall proceed in all respects in the opening of said Orchard street agreeably to the provisions of the ordinance providing for exercising certain powers vested in this corporation in relation to streets, approved May 15th, 1846, and shall receive the compensation therein provided, and the city collector shall perform such duties as are Duties of Reg. therein provided, and the city Register shall also perform the duties imposed on him, and receive the compensation as provided for in the aforesaid ordinance.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted and ordained, That in no event shall the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be responsible for any expense, cost or charge relating to or connected with the opening of said Orchard street.

Supplement to an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance relating to Public Schools," approved March 27, 1845.

Whereas, The purchase of books is a very heavy item of Preamble. expense in the annual support of the public schools; and whereas the commissioners of public schools should exercise the greatest caution in the admission of books into said schools, so that no loss may arise from their discontinuance after they have been received, unless from being worn, they are no longer fit for use; therefore,

Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and City Council When books of Baltimore, That the commissioners of public schools shall are to be adnot admit any book or books into the use of the public schools, when to be or discontinue the use of the same after having been admitted, discontinued unless said admission or discontinuance be approved by a vote in public of a majority of the entire board in session assembled, at a regular meeting of said board—any thing in any ordinance or resolution to the contrary notwithstanding.
