An ordinance to render effective Article 1st, Section 59, City Code of 1869, and the Amendment to said Section, page 14 of the Supplement to the City Code of 1874, relating to the Officers of the City and Appropriations of Money.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the heads of the several departments of the city government, as well as the officers or commissions that are charged with the making of contracts or the expenditure of the public money, shall, in making up their annual reports to the Mayor and City Council, or in submitting reports to the debtedness to be Stated in reports. Comptroller, as the case may be state the amount and for what purposes incurred. of their indebtedness respectively, and for what purposes or object such indebtedness was incurred.
