Benefit old material.

SEC. 3. And be it further ordained, That all old material now on the street, which is suitable for use in the cobble rebuts, shall be used, and the respective property owners shall receive the benefit of such old material in said street, in front of their respective properties, that is so used.

Monthly estimates.

SEC. 4. And be it further ordained, That the City Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make monthly estimates on the completed work on said Clifton avenue, and to draw his order on the City Comptroller for eighty (80) per cent., of each, respectively, of such estimates in favor of said contractor.

Unpaid sur

SEC. 5. And be it further ordained, That when the whole work provided for in this ordinance is finished and accepted by the City Engineer, all sums then remaining unpaid shall be paid to the contractor.

Repealing clause.

SEC. 6. And be it further ordained, That all ordinances and parts of ordinances heretofore passed, which are inconsistent with this ordinance or any of its provisions, be and they are hereby repealed.

No. 156.

An ordinance to provide for the repaying of McComas street, from the west side of Hanover street to the west side of Creek alley, and rekerbing the same where necessary.

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the City Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to have all that part of McComas street, from the west side of Hanover street to the west side of Creek alley, repaved with asphalt block, and to kerb or rekerb the same, where necessary, with five inch granite kerb; all of the said work shall be done in accordance with specifications to be prepared by the City Engineer, who shall advertise for proposals for doing the entire work.

SEC. 2. And be it further ordained, That the whole cost of repaving and rekerbing of the portion of McComas street, mentioned in the first section of this ordinance, shall be borne and paid by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore; and that the sum of thirteen thousand eight hundred (\$13,800) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated to defray the cost of the same, said sum to be taken out of the appropriation for repaving streets in the Ordinance of Estimates for the year 1904, and to be paid by the City Register on the warrant of the Comptroller of the city, to the abovenamed purpose, upon the order of the City Engineer, as provided in Section 6 of this ordinance.
