SEC. 2. And be it further ordained, That the cost of repaving and rekerbing of the portion of Ensor street mentioned in the first section of this ordinance, shall be borne and paid by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore; and that the sum of forty-six hundred (\$4,600) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated to defray the cost of the same, said sum to be taken out of the appropriation for repaving streets in the Ordinance of Estimates for the year 1904, and to be paid by the City Register on the warrant of the Comptroller of the City to the above named purpose, upon the order of the City Engineer, as provided in Section 6 of this ordinance.

SEC. 3. And be it further ordained, That the contract for doing the said repaving and rekerbing shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder therefor, after advertising for proposals therefor, and opening of bids therefor by the Board of Awards, in accordance with the terms of Sections 14 and 15 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1898, Chapter 123, known as the New Charter.

SEC. 4. And be it further ordained, That all the old material on said portion of Ensor street mentioned in the first section of this ordinance, which it is necessary to take up, shall be purchased by the contractor at a price to be named by him in his proposal, and the money therefor shall be paid to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, or shall be retained by said contractor, and credited by him against the amount due to him for the performance of the work under this ordinance.

SEC. 5. And be it further ordained, That the City Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make monthly estimates on the completed work on said Unpaid sums. Ensor street, and to draw his order on the City Comptroller for twenty per cent. of each, respectively, of such estimates in favor of said contractor.

SEC. 6. And be it further ordained, That when the whole work provided for in this ordinance is finished and accepted by the City Engineer, all sums then remaining unpaid shall be paid to the contractor.

SEC. 7. And be it further ordained, That all ordinances and parts of ordinances heretofore passed which are inconsistent with this ordinance, or any of its provisions, be and they are hereby repealed.
