An ordinance granting permission to Benjamin Sachs to place an electric sign in front of his premises, No. 1000 East Lombard street.

Permission granted for electric sign.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That permission be, and the same is hereby, granted to Benjamin Sachs to place an electric sign in front of his premises, No. 1000 East Lombard street, to extend from the building line to the curb, and to be supported from the building, and to be at least nine feet above the pavement, said sign to bear the words in incandescent electric lights, Hotel Sachs, and no other words.

SEC. 2. Be it further ordained, The sign shall be erected under the supervision of the Privilege re-vocable at any lime.

Inspector of Buildings, and the privilege time. hereby granted shall be revocable at any time by an order of the Mayor, or by an ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

SEC. 3. Be it further ordained, That the said Benjamin Sachs shall pay to the Mayor privilege granted. and City Council of Baltimore the sum of ten (\$10) dollars for the privilege above granted, the same to be paid before said sign shall be erected.
