An ordinance authorizing the Baltimore Yacht Club to fill in to the Bulkhead line a portion of the water front property recently purchased by said club near the foot of Light Street, and to erect a frame building thereon and a Pier extending therefrom.

Section 1. Whereas The Baltimore Yacht Club, a corporation, has recently purchased from the Winans' estate certain water front property described as follows:

Beginning for the same at a point three hundred and eighty-six feet south of Hammond Street on the west side of Marshall or Light Street, running thence west one hundred feet; thence south and parallel with Marshall Street to intersect the bulkhead line; thence southeasterly two hundred and twenty feet to what would be the east side of Marshall Street if continued beyond the shore line; thence northwesterly binding on the shore line to a point on the west side of Marshall Street; thence northerly along the west side of Marshall Street to the place of beginning.
