Thomas Gantt 1794 - Fielderia Manor -  
 to Tho. S. Lee { Beginning for the first part of  
 Fielderia Manor hereby intended to be  
 conveyed at the end of the 14<sup>th</sup> line of the  
 whole tract and running thence by and  
 with the 'outline' thereof, in succession  
 to the end of the 32<sup>d</sup> line of Fielderia Manor  
 aforesaid, then North 51 degree East 8 perches  
 to the end of the fifteenth line of a tract of  
 land called "The Lost Pen and Ink" it  
 being also the end of the fifth line of  
 that part of Fielderia Manor conveyed by  
 Thomas and Fielder Gantt to a certain  
 Joseph Myers then with said Myers part  
 of Fielderia Manor S 79 degree West 30 perches  
 + S 88 W 72 perches  
 to intersect the South 26 degree West  
 271 perch line of the said whole tract called  
 Fielderia Manor then by and with that line  
 S 26 W 78 perches to the end of that line,  
 thence with the outline of Fielderia  
 Manor aforesaid the seven following courses  
 S 19 W 144 S 41 E 10 S 22 W 83 } then by a straight  
 S 39 W 80 S 28 W 94 } line to first beginning  
 S 19 W 50 S 6 W 40 } 330 acres -
