two negro children - one
named John about four
years old the son of Juliana,
& the other named Phil
two years old the son of
Nancy - for the sum of \$300.
cash - they owning their
mothers & fathers -

April 11. Andrew Robinson
came this day to engage as
an overseer at the rate of
forty dollars per month
until the first of January
next -

He left the plantation Aug. 28.

1837. May 15. Deposited for collection
in Bank at Thibodauxville the
note of Messrs. Butler & Ellis, for
\$201. due Jan. 1, 1838. - paid
