My Dear Sir.

Yours before the last took a journey up into Pennsylvania; by some mistake getting into the wrong way - and going to Williamsport in that state - and only came to hand a few days ago.

I want to send you \$500, next week; if you must have it, but I am sure it is a great deal better than you can. I expect to go on with my hope are good. I think there is corn enough to be had. I may not stop before July. I have some hope for you - about 15 head. They will make fine ones - by fall.

I sent 40 head of sheep to Balto, averaging 190 lbs @ \$9/10 per cut.

I have got your letter saying you were coming up to Hagerstown to see Taylor, until I came back from Balto,
